Ask grandparents:

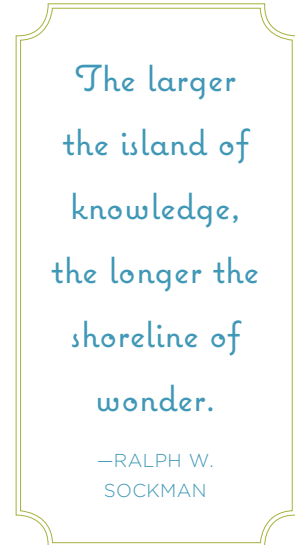
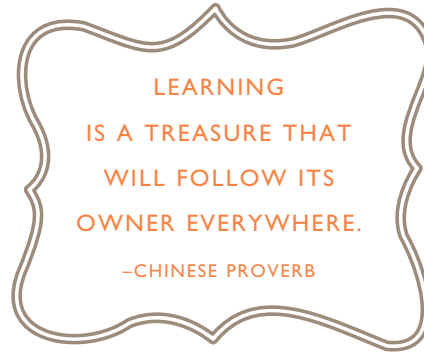
- What did you do for fun as a kid?
